
As you are aware, the membership of Local 634 has rejected your attempt at disaffiliation from the Philadelphia Joint Board. While our Joint Board has a continuing representational interest in the members of Local 634, we understand that the Philadelphia School Board is recognizing Local 634 under the existing collective bargaining agreement and we will assist your efforts as representation of these members to avoid any detriment to them. Accordingly, as we have stated, if you identify particular files that you need we will first make a copy of the file for our records and then release the original file to you. It would speed this process if you would cooperate by identifying in advance, the particular files that you need.

We do not object to Local 634's efforts to arrange for mail delivery to its new address. What we do object to is the Post office's refusal to deliver any mail to the Joint Board while it struggles to understand the difference between the Joint Board and your local union. We have insisted that the Post Office deliver mail to the Joint Board that is addressed to the Joint Board or any of its other local unions. We have not asked them to deliver mail addressed to Local 634 to us. This problem was brought on by the request you filed with the Post Office to forward mail to your new address. You might help clarify this situation by assuring them that you are not trying to get Joint Board mail forwarded to your new address. In the meantime we are not getting and have not gotten any mail that was addressed to your organization. In the unlikely event that checks made out to Local 634 are received by us we will forward them to you and we would expect the same courtesy in return.

I am not going to provide you with any records of the meeting that took place on April 11, 2009. You were there and tried your best to subvert the will of the membership by conducting a phony and hurried meeting before Local 634 members had a chance to speak or vote. You are aware that the majority of Local 634 members in attendance have rejected your leadership. Giving you the names of those Local 634 members would only expose them to harassment which they should not be forced to endure.

Finally, your request for the return of property covers items that were clearly purchased by the Joint Board as its own property – such as computers – and unknown personal items such as shoes. Attached is the property listing which you furnished together with our position regarding whether the particular items are Joint Board property.
