
 Polls are open from 7am-8pm. Your employer MUST allow you time to vote. To look up your polling place use the QR code


Sample Ballot










Once your ballot is complete, it needs to go inside **2** envelopes.

On Saturday, October 1, UNITE HERE members picketed alongside striking Philadelphia Museum of Art workers. Two weeks later, after 19 days on strike, the PMA union won a historic first contract with paid parental leave, wage increases, and more affordable healthcare.



Big Win for Aramark Club Box Servers and Runners

After Aramark announced that it was eliminating the Club Box Server position and threatening the jobs of over 20 Union members, Club Box Servers fought back to save their jobs – and won! They reached an agreement that creates a new classification, Club Attendants, which keeps everybody's seniority and lifts the pay from under
